

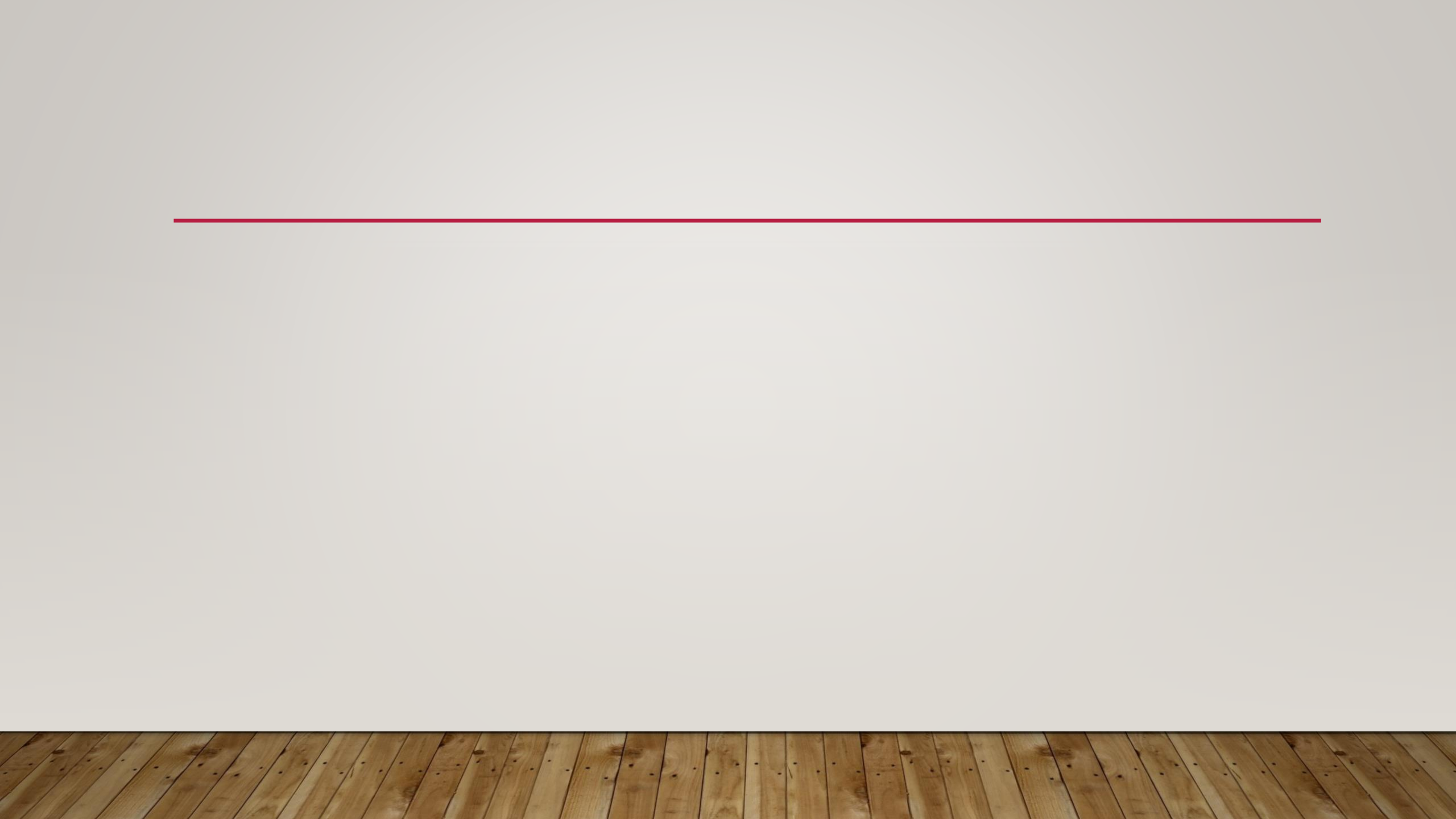

Evaluation of Colonial Missions

- William Carey envisioned a global missionary conference
- In 1910 it was realized: World Missionary Conference, Edinburgh, Scotland. 1200 representatives present.
- Coined the phrase “The Evangelization of the World in this Generation.”
- Association with colonial governments gave missions an imperialistic reputation or image
- Governmental paternalism reflected in missionary strategies as well

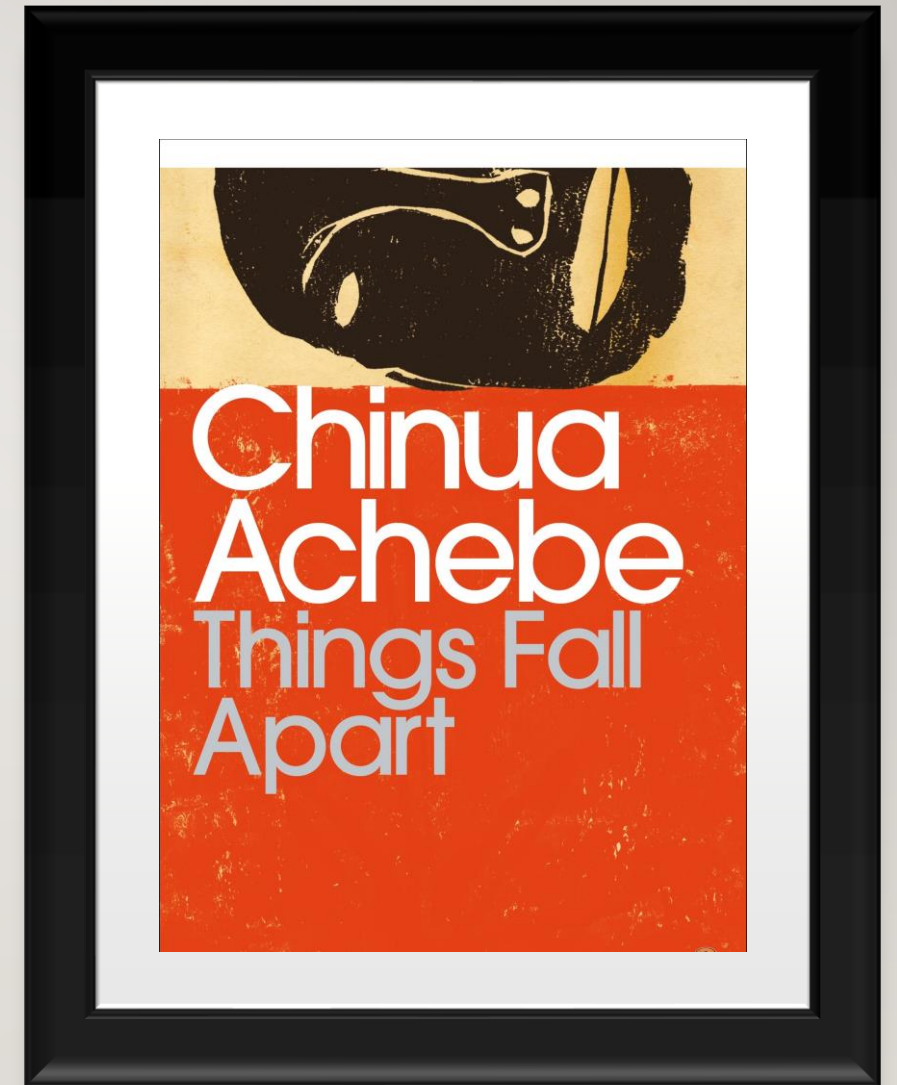




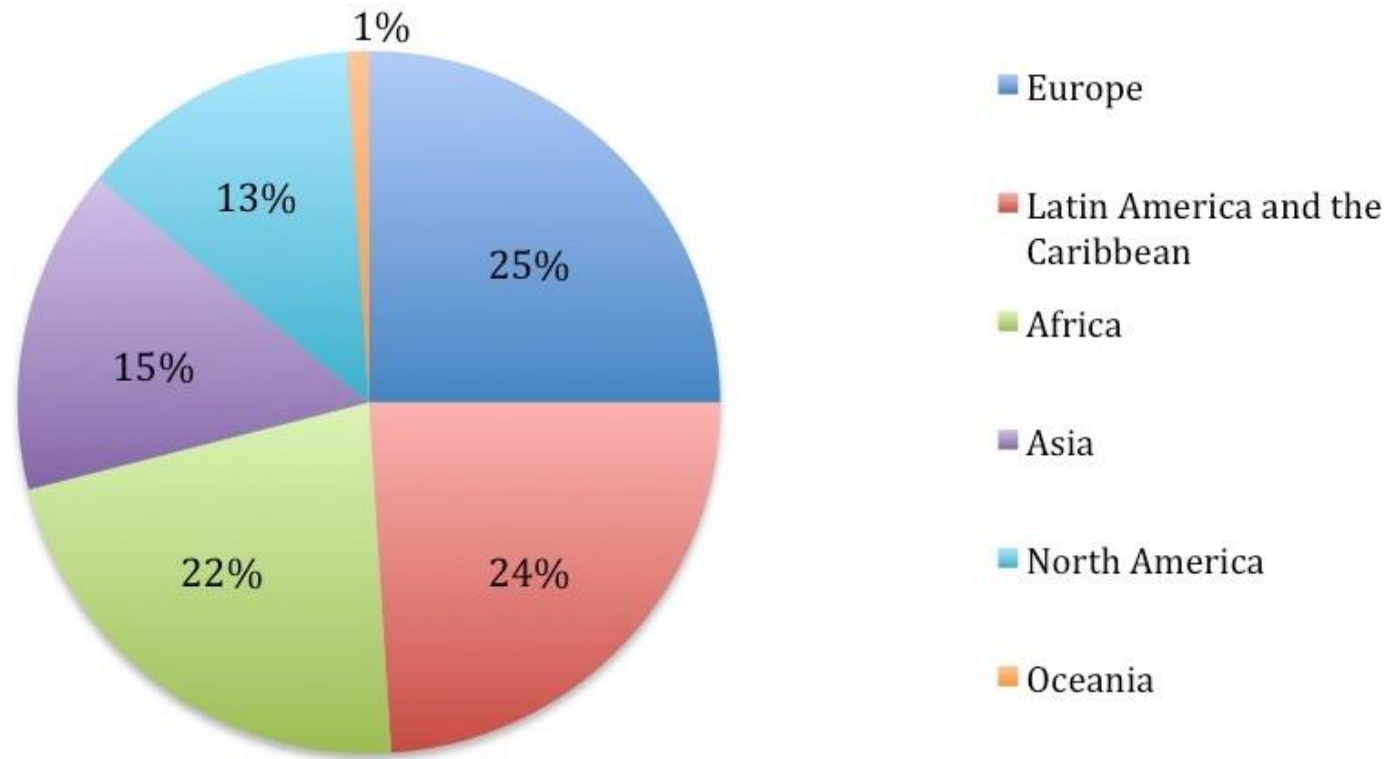
PATERNAL CHRISTIAN MISSION

Seeing people in Africa, Asia and elsewhere as backward, western missionaries were, supposedly, bringing them civilization out of their darkness and backwardness

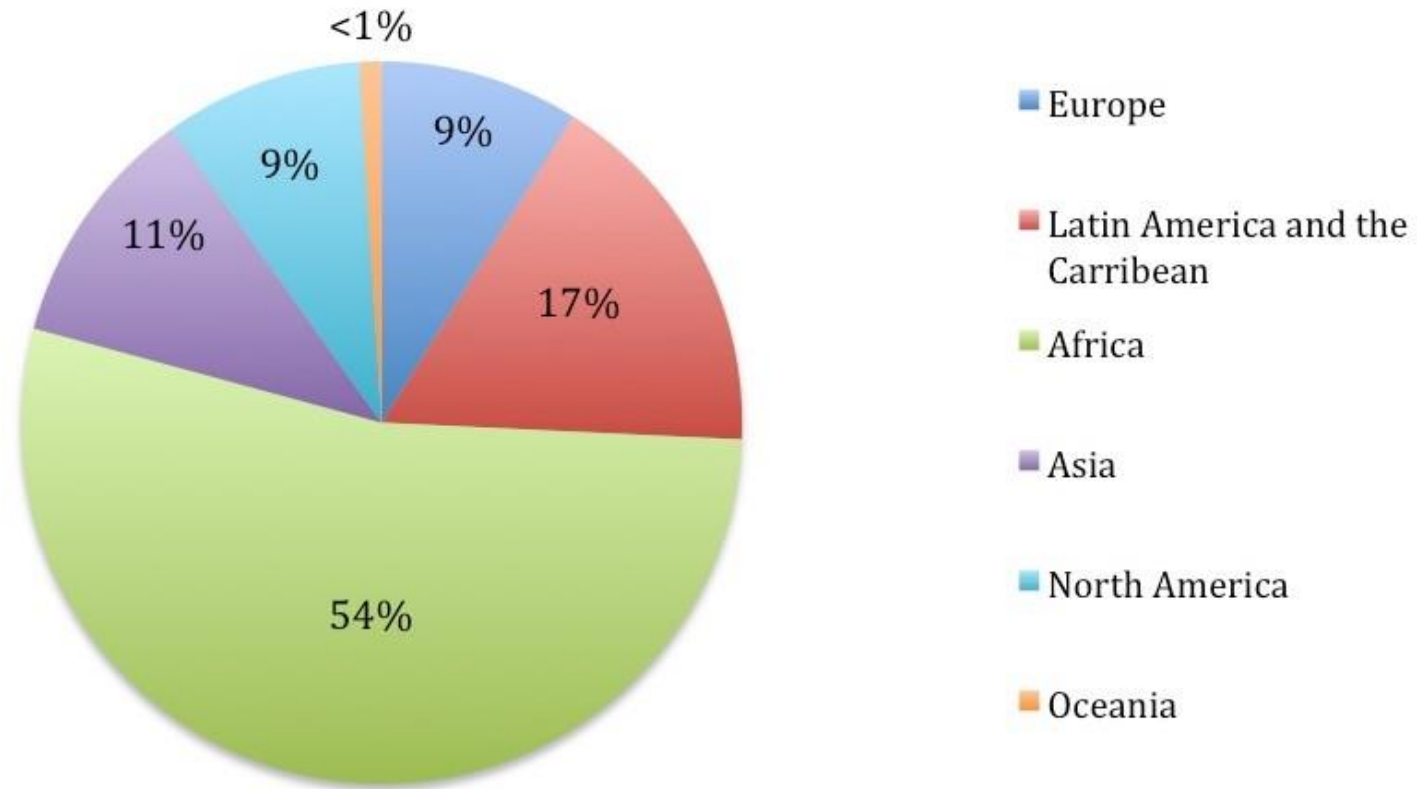

Global Christianity: 2015

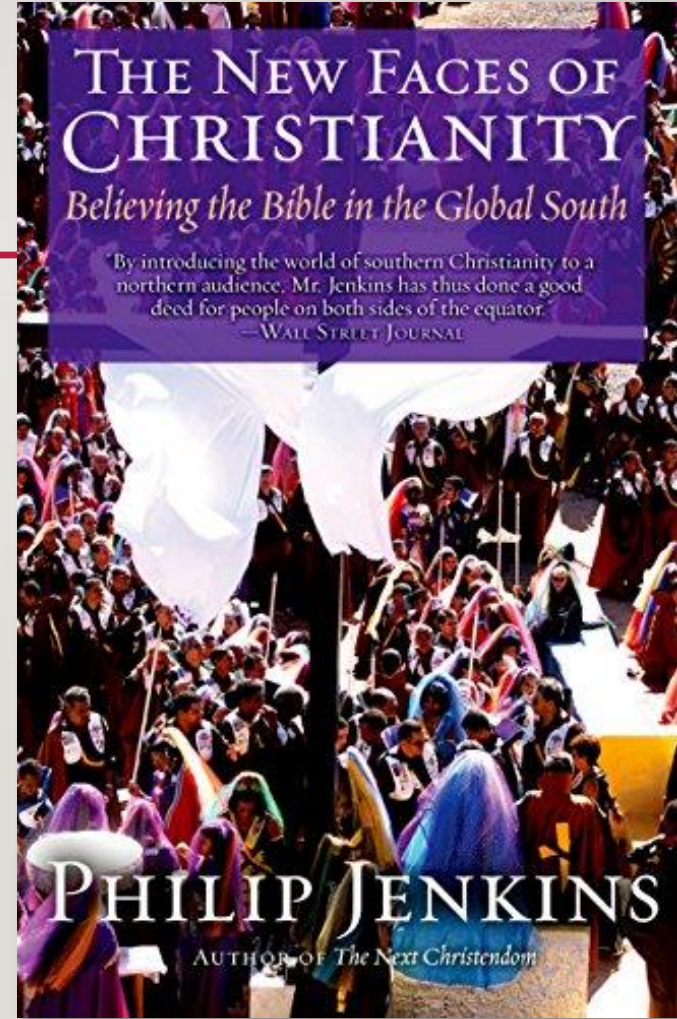
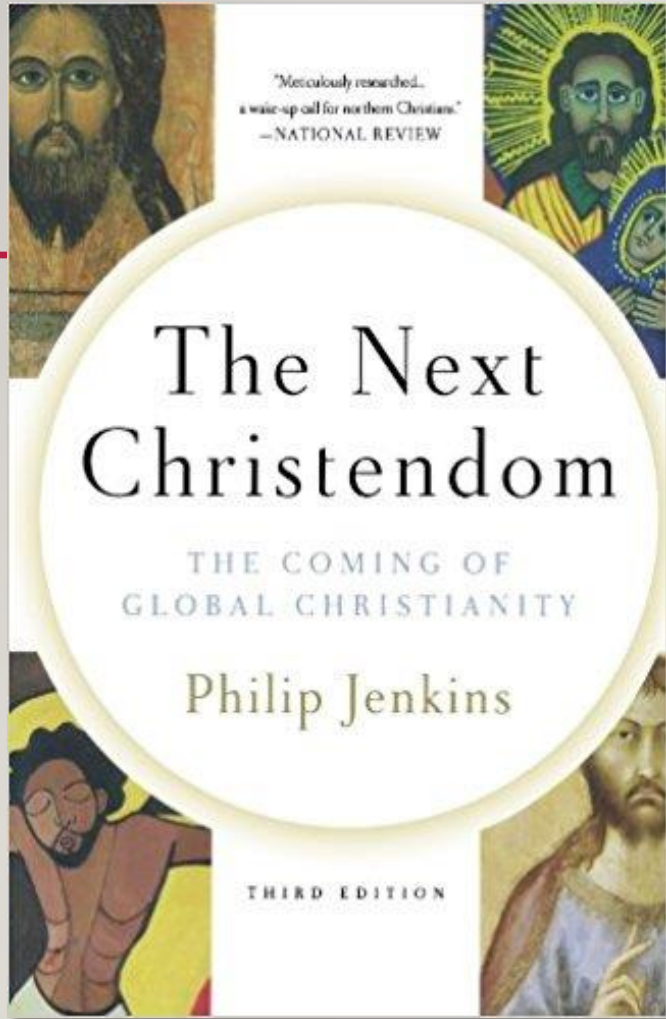


Global Christianity: 2100
